As proud host of the 2025 GloPent Conference, the Institute for Pentecostal Studies based at Uppsala University has taken the opportunity to bring together the field of Peace and Conflict research with research on Global Pentecostalism. The theme is both timely and internationally relevant and draws on Uppsala University's long history of education and research in the field of Peace and Conflict. We envisage an exciting conference which will contribute to a development of research in Global Pentecostalism in this regard.

We also welcome papers that address theories and methods in researching Global Pentecostalism in relation to Peace and Conflict, both scholarly and more action oriented, such as peace building and conflict prevention. The conference will also be open for papers addressing Global Pentecostalism more generally.
